Doctor of Education in Music Education

The Doctor of Education in Music Education is a joint program of the College of Education and the School of Music. Each candidate designs an individual program of study in consultation with his or her major professor and advisory committee. Students must complete a minimum of eighty semester hours beyond the baccalaureate degree. Twenty of these credits must be taken in consecutive semesters, one of which may be summer.
