#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Music minors must be admitted to the program by applying online (http://www.music.uga.edu) and passing an audition in voice or on an instrument for which we offer instruction. A grade of C or higher must be maintained for all music minor courses. Applied instruction in the auditioned instrument is part of the required coursework for a minor.
- Music minors must complete a minimum of 15 semester hours of coursework with at least nine hours of upper division coursework (3000 level or higher). Only three hours may be transferred in from another institution.
- Courses taken to satisfy University Core Areas I through V may not be counted as coursework in the minor.
- Courses taken in University Core Area VI may be counted as coursework in the minor.

- \* Two semesters of applied lessons are required. A jury is required after every two hours of applied study.
- \* Only one credit of MUSI 3700 can be used to satisfy the Applied Instruction area. Additional semesters of 3700 or 3800 can satisfy elective hours.

- 1. attend 15 recitals/concerts (verified by recital attendance card)
- 2. attend a weekly studio seminar
- 3. participate in an appropriate ensemble
